1. ORGANIZING AUTHORITY: Andrew Simpson Watersports Center Lake Garda S.S.D. a R.L., Via Riccardo Cozzaglio 1, email: lakegarda@aswc.it, 03391157767, www.aswc.it in collaboration Univela Sailing S.S.D. a R.L. and the Federazione Italiana Vela.

2. LOCATION AND EVENT PROGRAM: The race will take place in front of Campione del Garda with the following schedule::

Saturday 15 th of September	Registrations are open from 9:00 to 16:00
Sunday 16 th of September	Registration until 11:00

	Prize giving at the end of the race

3. RULES

3.1 The race will follow the regatta rules as WS 2017/2020 (RRS)

3.2 The rules stated in the "Normativa FIV per l'Attività Sportiva Nazionale Organizzata in Italia" have to be considered and rules.

3.3 The RRS 40 and the introduction to the fourth part have been modified as following::

1.4.a – "all competitors must wear a suitable flotation device, this could be a lifejacket or Buoyancy aid"

4. ADVERTISING: The organizing authority might ask the participants to apply advertising on their boats in the respect of the Regulation 20 W.S.

5. ADMISSION: All the dinghies, multi-hulls and foiling dinghies are allowed to participate. If you don't have a boat or you prefer to come in Campione del Garda without your own boat, you can request one of the boats available. See below the list of boats available to charter, with all proceeds going to the Andrew Simpson Foundation.

6. REGISTRATION: The registrations should be provided to the secretary office of the Andrew Simpson Watersports Center before 11:00 of the 16th of September 2018. **No fees are required in order to participate.** The secretary office will open at 9.00 of 15th of September. 7. NATIONAL SAILING ASSOCIATION MEMBERSHIP: All the competitors should follow their national rules and be compliant with the regulations according to their national authority.

8. INSURANCE: Every participant must be insured following the regulations stated in the Normativa Generale FIV with a minimum cover of € 1.500.000,00. The proof of insurance should be provided at the moment of the registration.

9. MEASUREMENT CERTIFICATS: All the boats must be able to provide a valid measurement certificate upon request.

10. MEASUREMENT CHECKS: The organizing authority is not planning any measurement checks.

11. NUMBER OF RACES AND RESULTS: The number of scheduled races is 1.

12. SAFETY AND SUPPORT BOATS: All the motorboats that are providing any sort of assistance to the participants should communicate their details to the secretary office.

13. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS: Sailing Instructions will be available at the secretary office during the registration process.

14. PRIZES: The prizes will be provided to the first 3 competitors using the handicap system to calculate the final results. More prizes will be provided according to the number of participants in each class.

15. LIABILITY: Competitors participate in the Regatta entirely at their own risk and responsibility. The responsibility for a boat's decision to participate in or to continue racing is hers alone. Competitors are advised to carefully assess weather conditions and risks related to the event, relying on the information provided by the Organizing Committee. Admittance to the Regatta does not imply that the Organizing Committee shall be in any way responsible for the crews' sailing skills. The safety of the yacht and its crew is the sole responsibility of the yacht owner, his/her representative or the skipper, and is not transferable; s/he shall do everything possible to guarantee the sound condition of the hull, mast, sails and all other material and equipment; s/he must also guarantee that the entire crew is capable of participating in the race and is aware of the use and location of life-saving equipment. Each race participant is responsible for his/her own safety and is advised to wear a personal flotation device which is adequate for the race.

16. IMAGES, VIDEO AND COPYRIGHTS: The participants are giving to the organizing authority the free use of any image and video that have been captured and produced during the event.
